Saint of the Week St Bernard of Clairvaux (1090-1153) was a reforming abbot of the Cistercian Order who came to our parish to open the monastery at Whitland just before he died. Often a controversial figure in life, he traveled Europe sorting out matters of church politics, but was also recognised as a great theologian and given the title 'Doctor Mellifluus'. He made a significant contribution to the theology of Mary writing the 'Memorare' prayer seeking her intercession.

FUNERAL Please pray for the repose of the soul of Mr Tom Ryan. His mortal remains shall be received into the Church at 7:30pm on Sunday evening. His funeral Mass is at 11:00am on Monday morning, prior to burial at City Road.

LAMPEDUSA CROSS In the past few years, hundreds of refugees have drowned off the coast of the Italian island Lampedusa. This prompted a local man to make crosses out of the wreckage of a sunken boat, which he gave to each survivor and to Pope Francis for the Year of Mercy. As we approach the end of the Holy Year, such a cross is being brought to our parish by CAFOD as a focus for a week of prayer, and to act as a reminder to us of the plight of refugees. Events in our week of prayer include: Thursday 22nd Sep at 7pm - Year of Mercy talk from CAFOD and arrival of the Cross. Sunday 25th Sep at 3pm - Holy Hour and Solemn Benediction. Tuesday 27th Sep at 7pm - Votive Mass for refugees. More information will be given closer to the time, but please make a note of the Week of Prayer in your diaries today.
