Saint of the Week St John Chrysostom (349-407) was a priest born at Antioch and who was an effective preacher - his name means golden mouthed! In later life he became Patriarch of Constantinople, but some of his reforms raised the ire of the emperor who sent him into exile twice. It was during his second exile to Armenia that he died, but not before having done much to explain and encourage the ways of Christian living to many faithful. We still today have many of his writings and homilies.

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMME The preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion takes place in Mary Immaculate School. If your child is not at the school, and you wish them to receive these sacraments next year, please make yourself known to Fr Liam. Those who are enrolled on the programme will be introduced to the parish at Sunday Mass on October 16th, when they and their families make a public commitment to their faith and start their preparations. Preparation for Confirmation takes place within the parish and classes begin at St David and St Patrick's on Saturday 15th October at 4:30pm. The class is open to anyone in Year 6 or above and parents should come with their children. This group of students will be introduced to the parish at Sunday Mass on October 23rd. If you wish to be enrolled and were not baptised in this parish, you will need to have a baptismal certificate to begin the course. If you have misplaced your Baptism Certificate, an additional copy may be obtained by contacting the parish of your baptism.
