**Saint of the Week** The celebration of St Michael and the archangels (*Michaelmas*) started in 5<sup>th</sup> Century Rome, when a Basilica was dedicated to St Michael. The celebration soon spread and, because it is near to the Autumn Equinox, it became an important day in the civic year when the nights became longer than the days. Not only did this day mark out Harvest time, but it was also one of the 'quarter days' on which financial accounts had to be settled. This day traditionally marks out the start of one of the four terms of the legal year and is the name given to the first of three terms of the academic year.

**MASS TIMES** Please take note of the irregular Mass schedule this week. On Tuesday there is no Hospital Mass owing to there being two other Masses that day (Canon Law restricts the clergy to two Masses on a weekday and three on a Sunday). I am away at the end of the week, but Deacon Tony will be available in the parish if required.
