Wednesday is the Feast of the Chair of Peter. It's both a celebration of a physical object, and of the Petrine Ministry which has been passed on through the Popes since the time of Peter himself. The actual chair can be found in St Peter's Basilica in Rome and overtime the simple wooden chair has become highly ornamented. Pope Benedict XVI has referred to it twice, but played down its physical significance as a possible relic, choosing to focus more on it as a reminder that Christ entrusted his Church on earth to the Apostles and their successors.
