Holy Saturday: Easter Vigil Mass, 8:30pm at Haverfordwest. Easter Sunday: Mass at 9:30am at Haverfordwest and Mass at 11:30am at Narberth.

During that week I will be in Lourdes with a group of disabled children joining about 3000 others from across the UK and beyond. As such, there will be no Masses in the Parish during Easter week.
