Holy Saturday: Easter Vigil Mass, 8:30pm at Haverfordwest.

Easter Sunday: Mass at 9:30am at Haverfordwest and Mass at 11:30am at Narberth.

The Chrism Mass takes place at St Joseph's Cathedral in Swansea and all are welcome to attend. The Cathedral is located at Convent Street, Swansea, SA1 2BX. At this Mass Bishop Tom will bless the oils and all the clergy will renew their ordination promises.

During that week I will be in Lourdes with a group of disabled children joining about 3000 others from across the UK and beyond.
