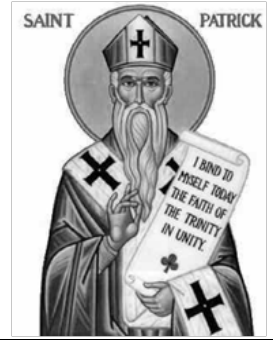

This Sunday has been designated as an INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER AGAINST HUMAN TRAFFICKING. The day was specially chosen because it was the Feast Day of St. Josephine Bakhita, a Sudanese slave who later became a nun. Today we have emerging new forms of slavery, with adults and children taken to unknown areas for forced labour and sexual exploitation. Pope Francis has become actively involved in stamping out these heinous crimes. There will be EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT in the Church on Monday, 10.30 – 11.30am/. There will be EXPOSITION available each weekday from 7 – 8am. Entry to the Church only by the Front Door. There is EXPOSITION in our Church at Narberth most weekday at 12 noon.

In response to the Popes request all families are invited to have an input into the second SYNOD ON THE FAMILY to be held in Rome in October. You are asked to fill in your answers to the 6 Questions on the Questionnaire and place them in the BOX provided after Easter. There is one Question every two weeks. The Question for the next two weeks is :

WHAT ARE YOUR STRUGGLES AND FEARS OF MARRIAGE AND FAMILY LIFE TODAY ?

You should keep all your observations on the six Questions and place them in one envelope and place it in the BOX provided in the Porches on Sunday after Easter (April 12th).

Pat Murphy will lead a DISCUSSION GROUP in the Resource Room on Thursday next which will help to clarify some aspects of this weeks Question and so help you in your answers.
