

In response to the Popes request all families are invited to have an input into the second SYNOD ON THE FAMILY to be held in Rome in October. You are asked to fill in your answers to the 6 Questions on the <u>Questionaire</u> and place them in the BOX provided after Easter. There is <u>one Question</u> every <u>two weeks</u>. There is a new Question to be considered this week: HOW CAN WE BETTER UNDERSTAND MARRIAGE AS A VOCATION?

You should keep all your observations on the <u>six Questions</u> and place them in one envelope and place it in the BOX provided in the Porches on Sunday after Easter (April 12th). Pat Murphy will lead a DISCUSSION GROUP in the Resource Room on <u>Thursday next</u> which will help to clarify some aspects of this weeks Question and so help you in your answers.
