SAINT OF THE WEEK A Roman Martyr of the early church she was beheaded by a sword c.230AD. She was a noble woman and is most often known as the patron of musicians. At her wedding it was said that when the music played, she sang her heart out to the Lord. She is one of seven women whose name appears in the texts of the Mass and her shrine is a place of pilgrimage today, in the Trastevere area of Rome. A statue of her depicts her blindfold awaiting her fate, with three fingers and one finger extended on each hand – a statement of belief of one God in three persons.
