SAINT OF THE WEEK St Nicholas (270-343AD) was a Bishop of the church at Myra in modern-day Turkey and is sometimes known as 'Nicholas the Wonderworker' on account of the number of miracles attributed to him. In the persecution of Diocletian he was imprisoned, but was later released by the Emperor Constantine and he was present at the Council of Nicaea. A well-loved historical figure, he is now most closely associated with the charitable story of placing three bags of money trough the chimney of a poor man's house so that his three daughters would have a dowry. As such he is often depicted holding three bags or balls of gold. More commonly, he is now referred to with his Germanic name, Santa Claus.

Parish Building Works Further progress has been made this week, but the lighting continues to pose a problem: owing to the Christmas season, the lighting won't be available until the New Year. Although very frustrating, the decision was taken to remove the scaffolding, even though the lights haven't been installed. This means that painting can continue and the loop-system can be installed: these tasks will have been completed by mid-week. On Monday the carpet fitters will carpet the organ loft and a basic, temporary lighting solution shall be installed. The damaged parts of the floor will be stained this week and then the floor shall be polished. The carpet fitters will return on the 11th December to lay the main carpet before the pews are returned. The altar has been encased in a wooden frame to give it more dignity and the sacristy area has been painted. Had the scaffolding remained in place, we would not have has use of the church during Christmas and this isn't really an option.

Once we are back in the Church the works, therefore, will not be fully complete; some decoration and lighting will be missing. However, once the New Year comes, a scaffolding tower can be hired and the new lamps installed. This will them complete the works.
