Saint of the Week. Thursday is the Feast of the Chair of Peter. It's both a celebration of a physical object, and of the Petrine Ministry which has been passed on through the Popes since the time of Peter himself. The actual chair can be found in St Peter's Basilica in Rome and overtime the simple wooden chair has become highly ornamented. Pope Benedict XVI has referred to it twice, but played down its physical significance as a possible relic, choosing to focus more on it as a reminder that Christ entrusted his Church on earth to the Apostles and their successors.

CAFOD LENTEN FAST The Lenten family fast takes place on Friday 23rd February. As part of our Lenten observance many of us will have given up some food for Lent: wine or chocolates or ice cream perhaps? Fridays are also the days in which we abstain from eating meat. These spiritual and penitential disciplines also save us some money and CAFOD makes a request each year that any money saved on the Lenten Fast Day, be generously donated to the Church's good works. In order to help facilitate this, envelopes are available this weekend in the porch and may be placed in next weekend's collection basket with your customary donation.

LENTEN STATION MASS This year our Denary Station Mass takes place at Tenby Parish Church on Tuesday 27th February at 7pm. It would be great is some of us could be there to represent our parish. (A Station Mass is one celebrated by the bishop, who would tour an area, stopping at different places to celebrate the sacraments.
