Saint of the Week. ST FRANCES OF ROME She was an Italian mystic and founder of the Oblates of the Benedictine order: women who lived part of the rule, but without taking vows. Born in 1384 she was married at 12 in a union that lasted for over 40 years. Tragically though her two children died in Rome which, in those days, was almost collapsed to ruins. She opened her home as a hospital for the poor of the city and was said to have seen visions. It is reported that she was able to read the secret thoughts of other people and to identify demonic plots. She is the patron saint of drivers as it is said she could see her guardian angel who would light the road in front of her as she travelled.
