Saint of the Week. ST PATRICK Born around 380AD St Patrick died in the mid 5th Century. His place of birth remains a matter for controversial debate, but we know he wasn't Irish. However, after spreading the Catholic Faith in those lands he was to become Patron Saint of the Irish people. He is also one of the patrons of our parish and so Mass this week will be celebrated on his feast day. As a day of solemnity it is a day which is exempt from the normal Lenten fasts. He is remembered for his simplicity and pastoral care, for his humble trust in God and for his fearless preaching of the Gospel to a group of people who had previously enslaved him in his youth.

Teams may be up to five people of all ages, and there will be a mixture of rounds. Please bring with you some food and drink to share with others. Entrance to the quiz is £3 per person.
