The Solemnity of the Annunciation recalls the event nine months before Christmas when the angel appeared to Mary and told her that she was to conceive a son - and Mary says 'yes' to God's plan for her life. This normally takes place on 25th March, but this year that day was Palm Sunday. The Church, not wishing to suppress such a major feast, therefore moves it in accord with a long-held tradition to the first day when there is no other feast being celebrated, which is Monday of this week. May I invite you all to come to Mass or to make a special effort to pray the Angelus on this day.
