Saints of the Week St Cyril of Alexandria was born c376 and died in 444AD. He was the Patriarch of Alexandria, a prolific writer and an instrumental theologian who resolved many Christological questions. He was present at the Council of Ephesus and argued against the heresy of Nestorius. Nestorius did not hold as true the concept of the Hypostatic Union, i.e. that Christ is both God and Man at the same time. St Cyril was a controversial figure and there were many who opposed him - in fact, he himself was condemned unjustly for heresy and deposed from his see.

**Confirmation** Next weekend, on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June at 6pm, we will welcome Bishop Tom to our parish as we celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. In preparation for this event there will be a rehearsal for confirmandi and their sponsors on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> June at 5:30-6:30pm (this is contrary to the notice previously given, because the previous date clashes with a school trip).

**Holy Day** The Solemnity of Ss Peters and Paul is celebrated on the 29<sup>th</sup> June. This day is a holy day of obligation and all should make the effort to come to Mass. There is a Vigil Mass at Narberth on Thursday evening at 7:00pm. On Friday morning Mass takes place in Haverfordwest at 10:00am, where we will welcome Mary Immaculate School. There will also be a Mass that evening at 7:00pm. Traditionally this is the day on which Peter's Pence is collected – a special collection for the Holy Father to use to support the Universal Church.

**Funeral** Please pray for the repose of the soul and the family of Mrs Elaine Shotton who died earlier this week, and whose funeral service will take place in the near future.
