Saints of the Week

St James the Son of Zebedee, was one of the 12 apostles and is traditionally considered the first apostle to be martyred. He was a fisherman and is often called James the Great so as to distinguish him for the other James (the less), the son of Alphaeus. A patron saint of Spain, he is most often associated with pilgrimage and the walking of the Camino to Compostella. It is said that he had a fiery temper and, as such, both he and his brother John earned the epithet "Boanerges" or "Sons of Thunder"
