HEARTY CONGRATULATIONS TO ARCHBISHOP MOST REV. MARK O'TOOLE...

On 9 November 2013, O'Toole was appointed the ninth bishop of Plymouth by Pope Francis. He received his episcopal consecration on 28 January 2014. He was the first new bishop of England and Wales appointed by Pope Francis. We pray with him for a fruitful ministry in the Archdiocese of Cardiff & diocese of Menevia.



POPE FRANCIS' APOSTOLIC LETTER – DESIDERIO DESIDERAVI: It reaffirms the importance of ecclesial communion around the rite that emerged from the post-conciliar liturgical reform. It is not a new instruction or a directive with specific norms, but rather a meditation on understanding the beauty of liturgical celebration and its role in evangelization. It concludes with an appeal: **"Let us abandon our polemics to listen together to what the Spirit is saying to the Church. Let us safeguard our communion. Let us continue to be astonished at the beauty of the Liturgy."** **Encounter with Christ:** **"The Christian faith is either an encounter with the living Jesus or it is not. The Liturgy guarantees for us the possibility of such an encounter. For us a vague memory of the Last Supper would do no good. We need to be present at that Supper."** Pope Francis

BEATIFICATION OF the "SMILING POPE" – JOHN PAUL I (04. 09. 2022) The Holy See Press Office announced plans on Monday for the beatification of Pope John Paul I, who was born as Albino Luciani in the northern Italian town of Forno di Canale (now Canale d'Agordo) on 17 October 1912. Pope Francis will preside over the beatification Mass in St. Peter's Square on Sunday, 4 September 2022. 'The Smiling Pope' Pope John Paul I's was the shortest papacy in history, reigning over the See of Peter for on 33 days. He was first Pope to choose a double name, saying he did so in honour of his two predecessors: John XXIII and Paul VI. He was also the last in the long line of Italian-born Popes which began with Clement VII in 1523. His successors—John Paul II, Benedict XVI, and Francis—have all praised the man known as "The Smiling Pope".



SYNOD: CARDINAL CZERNY: SYNODALITY IS THE WAY FOR INTEGRAL HUMAN DEVELOPMENT. The current synodal process is an important path to promoting integral human development for all ... Synodality offers a valid way forward to promote the God-given human dignity of all people... The Church's commitment to promoting integral human development. What we want for ourselves, we must logically promote for others" and, therefore, "all the People of God, the Bishops of the world, and the Holy Father with the Roman Curia are committed to promoting the integral human development" of those people to whom it is denied "especially to the poor", said the Prefect of the Dicastery. He recalled that Second Vatican Council decreed that the Church must focus on the goal of integral human development addressing the concrete realities that hinder its achievement in our world. "The joys and hopes, the griefs and the anxieties of the men of this age, especially those who are poor or in any way afflicted", are also the hopes and griefs of the Church which wants to share the Good News of salvation meant for every man", he said.
