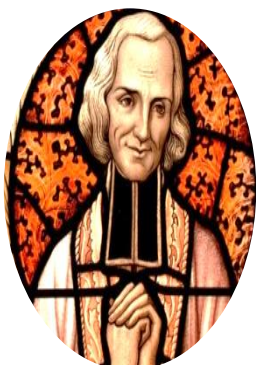

ST JOHN VIANNEY - PATRON SAINT OF PRIESTS - (Feast Day - 4th August)



Born in France in 1786, he became a priest in 1815. A few years later he was appointed as Priest of the village of Ars. He soon realised that many of its residents were either ignorant or indifferent to the faith and so over the next forty years he worked tirelessly to bring the people back to God. He became well known for his insightful homilies and commitment to offering confession (for up to 16 hours a day in the summer months).

He recognised the true importance of the priesthood in bringing the Gospel to the people. ***"The priesthood is the love of the heart of Jesus. When you see a priest, think of our Lord Jesus Christ."***
