

PARISH RENEWAL INITIATIVES: The Church invites us to undertake a spiritual renewal & re-focus, as the ongoing expression of Synod 2023 "Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart." Psalm 37:4... Seeking the Signs of the times echoed in our hearts. Convening the Second Vatican Council, Pope St John XXIII invited us to discern 'the signs of the times,'2 thereby participating in the Church's responsibility to 'scrutinise' what happens in our world through the lens of the Gospel. What are the 'joys and hopes, the griefs and anxieties' of our world and society today? Among the good wheat, we know there are weeds too which choke the harvest God intends for all people. For us to reap a good harvest, we know, for example, that we have a duty to defend human life and human rights, to rediscover the central value of marriage and family life, to eliminate injustice and to address the threat of climate catastrophe. We know, too, that the reality of warfare, hostility towards refugees and environmental recklessness are among the destructive forces at work in our world. Similarly, the rising costs of living, food poverty, homelessness and challenges to mental health are just some of the issues which impact the wellbeing of so many.

While that is the right direction to move, we would need more volunteers to open the church for the specified hour or so & close. POPE FRANCIS TO YOUNG PEOPLE: MAY JESUS BECOME YOUR GREAT FRIEND... Pope Francis reassures young people that Jesus is their friend, their companion, whom they should turn to always, and says that God loves questions. May Jesus become "your great friend," "your companion along the way," and "life," Pope Francis has told young people. **The Pope recognized that those before him must have countless questions, and urged them to bring them forth, as "God loves questions."** Christ never abandons you and will restore you.

The Holy Father reminded the youth of his Apostolic Exhortation "Christus vivit," where he encourages them to treasure their relationship with Christ. "I started with these words: 'Christ is alive! He is our hope. In a wonderful way, He brings youth to our world and everything He touches becomes young, new and full of life... Christ is alive and He wants you to be alive!" "He is in you, He is with you and He never abandons you. However far you may wander, He is always there, the Risen One. He calls you, and He waits for you to return to Him and start over again. When you feel you are growing old out of sorrow, resentment or fear, doubt or failure, He will always be there to restore your strength and your hope" When faced with the evil that is within us and around us, the Pope insisted that we are not to evade reality nor close in on ourselves, but to shoulder, each one of us, our own share of responsibility.
