**EDUCATION SUNDAY - 11 SEPTEMBER 2022:** Education Sunday is a significant occasion in the calendar of the Church in England and Wales. Taking place at the start of the academic year, this day offers an opportunity for us to pray to Almighty God for all people involved in Catholic education, to celebrate the achievements of the past and to ask Our Lord to bless the work of the year ahead. The theme of this year's Education Sunday is 'Enlightening the Mind' and is based on the Gospel acclamation for that day: **"May the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ enlighten the eyes of our mind, so that we can see what hope his call holds for us" (Eph. 1:17,18).** In St John's Gospel, Our Lord teaches us: **"If you make my word your home you will indeed be my disciples, you will learn the truth, and the truth will make you free" (Jn 8:31,32).** Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, and the revelation of his word, is 'the foundation of the whole educational enterprise in a Catholic school. His revelation gives new meaning to life and helps man to direct his thought, action and will according to the Gospel, making the beatitudes his norm of life.' The enterprise of Catholic education, whether in the home, school, college or university, is built on the belief that it is God our Father who enlightens the eyes of our minds. Through his gift of grace, he enables us to discover him and come into a relationship with him in Christ, the one source of all truth and freedom.

**EVANGELII GAUDIUM SUNDAY/HOME MISSION SUNDAY - 18<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2022:** What was formerly called Home Mission Sunday, is now Evangelii Gaudium Sunday.
