Evangelii Gaudium Sunday will be celebrated in Catholic parishes throughout England and Wales on Sunday, 17th & 18th September 2022, with a Retiring Collection. Kindly Gift Aid your donation.

POPE FRANCIS' CONDOLANCE MESSAGE FOR HER MAJESTY & THE ROYAL FAMILY ***"Pope Francis praises Queen Elizabeth's 'steadfast witness of faith in Jesus Christ.'*** Pope Francis in a telegram late Thursday offered his condolences and prayers upon the death of Queen Elizabeth II, Britain's longest-reigning monarch and the head of the Church of England. "Deeply saddened to learn of the death of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, I offer heartfelt condolences to Your Majesty, the Members of the Royal Family, the People of the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth," the pope wrote in the Sept. 8 telegram to Britain's new monarch, King Charles III. ***"I willingly join all who mourn her loss in praying for the late Queen's eternal rest, and in paying tribute to her life of unstinting service to the good of the Nation and the Commonwealth, her example of devotion to duty, her steadfast witness of faith in Jesus Christ and her firm hope in his promises."*** Ascending to the throne in 1952, Queen Elizabeth II met five different popes during her lifetime. When she met with Pope Francis at the Vatican in April 2014, she gave the pope a food hamper filled with local delicacies and a bottle of Balmoral whiskey — from the same region in Scotland where she died on Thursday. ***The meeting between Elizabeth and Francis marked the 100th anniversary of the re-establishment of diplomatic relations between the United Kingdom and the Holy See.***
