WORLD MISSION SUNDAY- 23. 10. 2022: A World Mission Sunday is a day set aside for the Catholic Church throughout the world to publicly renew its commitment to the missionary movement, coordinated by the Pontifical Mission Societies (Missio.) It falls on the penultimate Sunday of October every year. Created by Pope Pius XI in 1926, it's the day of prayer for missions.

MESSAGE OF POPE FRANCIS FOR WORLD MISSION SUNDAY: "You shall be my witnesses" (Acts 1:8): The call of every Christian to bear witness to Christ. These words were spoken by the Risen Jesus to his disciples just before his Ascension into heaven, as we learn from the Acts of the Apostles: 'You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth' (1:8). They are also the theme of World Mission Sunday, which, as always, reminds us that the Church is missionary by nature. This year World Mission Sunday offers us the opportunity to commemorate several important events in the Church's life and mission: the fourth centenary of the founding of the Congregation de Propaganda Fide, now the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples, and the second centenary of the Society of the Propagation of the Faith. A hundred years ago, the latter, together with the Society for the Holy Childhood and the Society of St. Peter the Apostle, was granted the title 'Pontifical.'"
