READINGS: SUNDAY – 27TH NOVEMBER 2022 – 1ST SUNDAY OF ADVENT (YEAR A)

1st Reading: Isaiah 2: 1-5

Psalms: 121: 1-2, 4-5, 6-9

SYNOD 2023: We are in receipt of "The Working Document for the Continental Stage (DCS)." We are asked to give responses to the Working Document for the Continental Stage by responding to three questions (from chapter 4 of that Document), namely: **1. "After having read and prayed with the DCS, which intuitions resonate most strongly with the lived experiences and realities of the Church in your continent? Which experiences are new, or illuminating to you?"** **2. "After having read and prayed with the DCS, what substantial tensions or divergences emerge as particularly important in your continent's perspective? Consequently, what are the questions or issues that should be addressed and considered in the next steps of the process?"** **3. "Looking at what emerges from the previous two questions, what are the priorities, recurring themes and calls to action that can be shared with other local Churches around the world and discussed during the First Session of the Synodal Assembly in October 2023?"**

In order to facilitate this process, I suggest and invite all of you join in two parish gatherings on December 04th & 11th, after Sunday Holy Mass & Tea. In addition, I would like to invite any parish group or individuals to respond personally too. If you going to do so, kindly let me know.
