

The Vatican press office director, Matteo Bruni, said Dec. 31: "With sorrow I inform you that the Pope Emeritus, Benedict XVI, passed away today at 9:34 in the Mater Ecclesiae Monastery in the Vatican." Benedict XVI's body will lie in state in St. Peter's Basilica beginning on Jan. 2, 2023. His funeral Mass will be held on Jan. 5, 2023, in St. Peter's Square, the Vatican said.
