MESSAGE OF POPE TO YOUNG UK CATHOLICS: "DARE TO TESTIFY TO CHRISTIAN IDEALS... SET FREE BY THE GOSPEL..."

Pope Francis sent his greetings and encouragement to participants to the tens of thousands of young Catholics from across England and Wales who gathered at the OVO Arena Wembley, in London, for the 5th CYMFed Flame Congress... The event was held 150 days before the 37th World



Youth Day—to be held in Lisbon, Portugal, on 1-6 August 2023—under the theme "Rise Up!", an echo of the WYD Scripture passage: **"Mary arose and went with haste"**. In a message the Pope assured the young Catholics of his "spiritual closeness" and prayed that "Almighty God will richly bless their time together". He expressed his hopes that **"through adoration, music, testimonies, and the sharing of friendship with Christ and with one another, all present will grow strong in faith and love and bear witness courageously to the Gospel message that sets us free."** The Pope also urged them to hasten to respond to the Lord's call to follow Him, as did Mary the Mother of God. **"Dare to be different [and] point to ideals other than those of this world, testifying to the "BEAUTY OF GENEROSITY", service, purity, perseverance, forgiveness, fidelity to our personal vocation, prayer, the pursuit of justice and the common good, love for the poor, and social friendship."** Pope Francis

DIVINE MERCY FILM & NOVENA: In the 1930's our Lord revealed this message to Sr. Faustina Kowalska, **"Mankind will not have peace until it turns with Trust to My Mercy."** The incredible true story of St. Faustina and the message of the Divine Mercy are now documented in the acclaimed film, **"Love and Mercy, Faustina."** On April 1st, at 2 pm, there will be an opportunity to see this film in the Church Hall. All are welcome. Refreshments will be provided. This will be a good preparation, for Divine Mercy Novena which begins on Good Friday.

POPE'S MARCH PRAYER INTENTION: FOR THE VICTIMS OF ABUSE: "In response to cases of abuse, especially those committed by members of the Church, it is not enough to ask for forgiveness," said Pope Francis, announcing his prayer intention for March 2023. The Pope this month is praying in a special way for victims of abuse. In his message, he insists that victims must be the protagonists of a response to abuse... their pain and psychological wounds can begin to heal if they find answers – if there are concrete actions to repair the horrors they have suffered and to prevent them from happening again... Pope Francis insists, too, that the Church cannot hide abuse, no matter where it occurs, but instead must serve as a model in its response to abuse – including by shining a light on the issue of abuse in society and in families. As part of that response, the Church must also **"offer safe spaces for victims to be heard, supported psychologically, and protected."** "Let us pray for those who have suffered because of the wrongs done to them from members of the Church; may they find within the Church herself a concrete response to their pain and suffering."

Victims of the Turkey/Syria earthquake & Young People from the Dioceses attending World Youth Day. **St. Augustine wrote about fasting and mortification: "Don't believe that fasting suffices. Fasting punishes you, but it does not restore your brother! Your fasting will be fruitful if you provide for the needs of another. How many poor people could be nourished by the meal, you did not take today?"**
