#### READINGS: SUNDAY 19<sup>TH</sup> MARCH – 4<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY OF LENT (LAETARE)

In that time, he has made a huge impact on the Church, leading his flock with a pastoral zeal that has been felt across the globe. A historic election...
