ASSISTED SUICIDE BILL: Our Archbishop, Most Rev Mark O'Toole expressed his views and concerns through his Pastoral letter to oppose an Assisted Suicide Bill. UNIFICATION CELEBRATIONS: Archbishop Most Rev Mark O'Toole is to receive a new Papal Bull for the erection of a united Archdiocese of Cardiff-Menevia. To mark the occasion, in the presence of the Clergy, Religious and Lay Faithful of our new Archdiocese, a celebration will take place, on Monday 2nd December, at 12 noon, in the Metropolitan Cathedral of St. David, Cardiff.
