REMEMBRANCE CROSSES: Memorial Crosses will once again be for sale this weekend and next weekend. They are £5 per cross and these will be incorporated in the flower display for Remembrance Sunday. Please speak to a member of the flower group if you would like to dedicate a cross.

ASSISTED SUICIDE BILL: Our Archbishop, Most Rev Mark O'Toole expressed his views and concerns through his Pastoral letter to oppose an Assisted Suicide Bill.
