This weekend's parish fundraising event of Asian recipes takes place on Sunday from 12pm. You will be introduced and given a taste of some Asian continental recipes from India, the Philippines, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, and Thai/Korean.

Tickets are priced at £14 per adult and £6 per child aged 5-12 years. Children under 5 go free. Tickets are available from the Hall Committee and the Refreshment Group or by completing the sign-up sheets in both porches. Booking is essential to give the chefs an idea of numbers.

The menu includes: Chicken Curry with peas, pilau, lentils, and vegetables (gluten-free); Chicken and Lamb Kebabs with samosas in a Pakistani style; Prawn Curry with vegetables, fried rice, fried chicken, curry with vegetables, and salad, and Payasam pudding in an Indian style. Thai/Korean Barbeque, fish, selection of meats, noodles, and vegetables. Beef Kaldereta and vegetable spring rolls in Filipino style.
